Residential Services

Residential Treatment Program

This program provides innovative treatment for adolescent girls with serious mental health and behavioral challenges, many of whom have suffered abuse, neglect, and other traumatic events. The program uses evidence-based therapies to provide residents with clinical services, therapeutic activities, and on-site education. A hallmark of this program is the integration of creative arts therapies, including art, dance and movement, music, equine, pet, and recreational therapy. Our goal is to instill a sense of hope and resilience that helps girls to recover from their behavioral health challenges.

Supervised Independent Living Program

A transitional living experience for young women preparing for independence — particularly those who have been in foster care or a residential program. Residents benefit from supervised apartment living, life skills education, counseling, and case management and healthcare services. In addition, residents also receive support in pursuing educational and vocational goals in the community.

Group Home Cottage

Services for adolescent girls in a campus-based group home who are referred for placement by county children and youth agencies due to instability in their current home, or as a step-down residence as they prepare for their return home. This program serves girls who do not require intensive behavioral health therapies, but who can benefit from the structure, supervision and counseling services of residential placement.

Community Based Services

Foster Care and Kinship Care

Temporary placement in safe and nurturing homes for children who are removed from their parents' custody due to their inability to properly care for their child. Treatment foster care is also available for children with serious mental and behavioral health challenges.

Adoption

Connects children in foster care whose parental rights have been terminated with a forever family. Post-permanency case management services are available after placement to ensure ongoing support and a successful adoption.

Programming during non-school hours for at-risk children that emphasize academic enrichment activities and social skills development, as well as full-time programming during the summer.

Therapy, medication management, and psychiatric services for children, adolescents, adults and families. TheVillage specializes in Play Therapy, Trauma Focused-Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, and Parent Child Interactive Therapy.

In-Home Protective Services

An array of services for families who have been reported to the Child Abuse Hotline, but for whom the Department of Human Services has determined there are no active safety threats. These services are designed to strengthen families and prevent children's foster care placement.

Family Empowerment Services

A series of services designed to strengthen families and avoid children's placement in foster care. This program caters to families for whom the Department of Human Services has determined there is an active safety threat.
